The Newark Town Board is seeking to recruit two additional voluntary Board Members to support the delivery of the transformational £20 million Pride in Place Programme in Newark over the next decade.

We are seeking expressions of interest from individuals with a deep connection to the Newark community, ideally representing either a local business or a registered community organisation, or charity operating within the [Newark Pride in Place boundary, including:](#)

- Community leaders, organisers and advocates, such as representatives of local charities, faith groups and constituted community organisations, particularly those working with under-represented communities.
- Local businesses and social enterprises, including local retailers, employers, members of the Chamber of Commerce or Business Improvement District, registered social housing providers, and co-operatives.

The role

Please note that this is a voluntary role, with no expenses payable. The role of Board Members includes identifying local priorities, engaging residents, and contributing to decisions on how funding is invested to improve local infrastructure and services.

The role requires members to act in the interests of the wider Newark community and be committed to being an advocate of the Pride in Place programme and the boards existing [Regeneration Plan](#).

Members will be expected to attend Board meetings within Newark. Typically held every other month and lasting approximately two hours.
